

## **The ACMP Carolinas Chapter Board of Directors**

ACMP Carolinas Chapter Board of Directors elections are held annually, in October, to fill open positions for the next calendar year.

The Carolinas Chapter was formed in 2020 by consolidating the previous Raleigh and Charlotte chapters, also with the goal to begin serving the entire Carolinas region. For 2021, all positions are available, because this will be the first time that elections will be held for this newly formed Chapter.

2021 will be a pivotal year for the ACMP Carolinas Chapter, and we are both filling our Board positions and looking for additional volunteers as well. ### **Board of Directors expectations:**

**Time commitment:** Each Board of Directors position requires a minimum of 6-10 hours per month. You will be expected to attend monthly meetings, plus additional meetings as needed, and will be held accountable for a set of responsibilities defined for you and your committee (if your Position involves leading a committee).

**Passion for serving your community:** The ACMP Carolinas Chapter is a non-profit organization, and Board positions are volunteer roles. Our Chapter, as defined by our Charter and By-laws, is an organization that is dedicated to serving the change management community within the Carolinas. As a Board member, your enthusiasm and motivation should be driven by a desire to fulfill our Chapter's Charter, with a focus on serving the community.

**Affinity to Change Management:** You will need to demonstrate strong interest and knowledge of the change management discipline. While it is not a full requirement that your occupation and experience is within change management directly, you need to show a strong understanding of change management practitioner role and what is needed for change management to be successful. A change management certification, such as PROSCI or CCMP would be a plus.

**Willingness to collaborate:** Team culture is incredibly important to the ACMP Carolinas Chapter. Board members should be highly collaborative, able to take feedback and recommendations well, be good leaders to their volunteers, and have fun too.

### **ACMP Global Membership, with ACMP Carolinas Chapter selected as your primary chapter:**

In order to serve on the Board, it is mandatory that your ACMP membership is in good standing, and that you select the ACMP Carolinas Chapter as your primary chapter.
